

SLIDING SCALE

SPEECH JUDGES

LOW

HIGH

- Place first speaker in the middle of the line, label with #1 – list their school, notes about the topic, and judgments regarding the speech.
- Each speaker after that, rate as higher or lower on the scale than the first and where they fit in between the other speakers.
- Judges can then compare their sliding scales with the individual score sheets for each speaker and compare the points to the scale
