2022 <u>Electronic Resources</u> - Policy was completely revised by WSSDA in 2008. Cross References updated. Management Resources added

2023 <u>Lesson Plans</u> - Renumbered (2123). Slight changes in wording. Legal References added

2025 <u>Copyright Compliance</u> - The district policy and procedure were merged into one 7 page document and need to be separated into two documents. Page 1 of the document is identical to the first section of the WSSDA policy. Pages 2-7 belong in the procedures. Last 3 paragraphs added to policy. Cross References added. Legal References added. Management Resources added

2104 <u>Federal and/or State Funded Special Instructional Programs</u> - Title I content added in last couple of paragraphs. Legal References updated

2106 <u>Program Compliance</u> - Renumbered (2114). 1985 district policy. Content updated in several places. Cross References updated. Legal References deleted

2108 <u>Remediation Programs</u> - District policy was adopted in 2000 - WSSDA updated the policy in 2005. Substantial differences in content. Cross References updated. Legal References updated. Management Resources updated

2125 <u>Sexual Health Education</u> - Renumbered (2335) and re-titled. 1985 district policy that has been completely revised by WSSDA, most recently in 2007 and 2009. Cross References added. Legal References added. Management Resources added

2140 <u>Guidance and Counseling</u> - 1980 district policy updated significantly in 2008 in response to legislative changes. Legal References updated

2150 <u>Co-curricular Program</u> - 1980 district policy updated completely. Legal References updated. Cross Reference added. Legal References updated

2161 <u>Education of Students with Disabilities</u> - District policy was adopted in 2000 - WSSDA updated the policy in 2007. Shaded section describes an option for district to consider when determining content for the policy. Examine both policy and procedures. Some of the district policy is covered in the procedures. Substantial differences in content. Cross References updated. Legal References updated. Management Resources added

2170 <u>Career and Technical Education</u> - Renumbered (2164) and re-titled. 1980 outdated district policy. Changes in terms from 'vocational' education to 'career and technical' education. Legal References added. Management Resources added

2178 <u>Traffic Safety Education</u> - Two district policies with same title and content. 2163 is dated 1980 and should have been deleted in 2002 when 2178 was adopted. Some differences in content between the district 2178 and the

WSSDA 2178. Legal References updated

2180 <u>Parent, Family and Community Partnerships</u> - Optional policy so the district has discretion in adopting the wording that best meets the needs of the district. Review the differences in content

2190 <u>Highly Capable Programs</u> - Renumbered (2166) and re-titled. 1985 district policy has been updated by WSSDA. Legal References updated. Management Resources added

2210 <u>Grade Organization</u> - Differences between district and WSSDA policies. Optional policy. Wording should be reviewed to determine what best meets the needs of the district

2220 <u>School Calendar</u> - One sentence difference to review. Legal References updated

2331 <u>Controversial Issues/Guest Speakers</u> - Two 1980 district policies were merged into one policy. Content was updated by WSSDA

2333 <u>Flag Exercises</u> - Slight update. Legal References updated. Management Resources added

2340 <u>Religious-Related Activities and Practices</u> - No changes to content. Legal References updated.
