This is an exciting year for the Creston Alumni Association and our scholarship program. As we celebrate the seventeenth year of awarding scholarships to our graduates, we are reminded that we would not be where we are today if it were not for the generosity of our members and donors. Because of your continued support we are thrilled to announce that in June we awarded eighteen scholarships totaling \$18,000, bringing the grand total of scholarships awarded to date to \$200,135! Six scholarships were awarded to graduating seniors, eleven to former recipients, and one to a former graduate. Former recipients who received scholarships of \$850 each were Tyler Covey, a pre-nursing student at WSU; Alyssa Dillhoff, continuing at Spokane Falls Community College; Ashley Flinner, a pre-pharmacy student attending the University of Wyoming; Colleen Heaton, a nursing student attending the University of Montana; Erinn Kane, a senior business major attending Eastern Washington University; Jeff Krause, studying for a Masters of Business Administration degree at Western Washington University; Mary Pebles, a sophomore at Spokane Falls Community College studying graphic design; Dena Riechman, a fourth year dental student at the University of Michigan; Julie Salinas, a sophomore journalism major at North Idaho College; Karrie Sieverkropp, attending Spokane Falls Community College in general studies, and Jacob Struve, a sophomore Natural Resource Management student at Spokane Community College. Tyler Schmidt, a 2010 Creston graduate is attending Everett Community College studying Fire Science.
