## Fourteen Scholarships Total \$12,000

The Creston Alumni Association is pleased to announce fourteen scholarships totaling \$12,000 were presented in June 2010. Four were awarded to graduating seniors, eight to former recipients continuing their education, and two were awarded to former graduates. The association extends its congratulations to these students.

The four high school graduates will each receive \$1000 in funds when they have successfully completed their first quarter or semester of college. Those students are: Michelle Brimberry, planning to attend Spokane Community College; Tyler Covey, who plans to attend Whitworth University; Karrie Sieverkropp, and Brianna Springer, who both will be attending Eastern Washington University.

The following former scholarship recipients will each receive \$850: Eric Crowell, attending Eastern Washington University to earn a master's degree in urban and regional planning; Erinn Kane, continuing studies in business at Eastern Washington University; Ben Lembcke, a senior psychology major at the University of Washington; Dena Riechmann, a sophomore at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry, Jodi Robertson, an early education major at Eastern Washington University, Mandy Runkel, a junior majoring in education at Whitworth University; Karl Sieverkropp, a junior agriculture technology major at Washington State University, and Kylee Struve, a graphic design student at Spokane Falls Community College.

R.J. Hopkins will receive \$900 to continue studying diesel heavy equipment technology at Spokane Community College, and Alyssa Dillhoff will receive \$300 to continue studies at Spokane Falls Community College.

This association is dedicated to providing financial assistance to our graduates. Because of your membership support, generous scholarship donations and memorials, in fifteen years the Creston Alumni Association has awarded \$166,835.00 in scholarships. 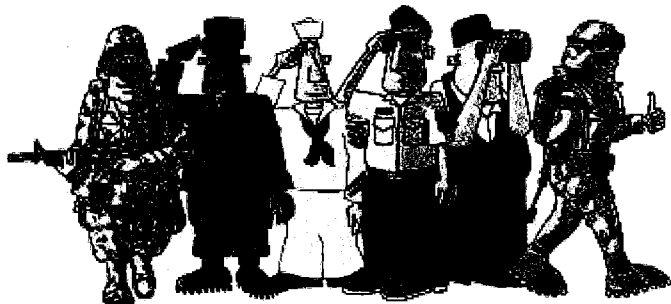
