Sixteen Scholarships Total \$15,000

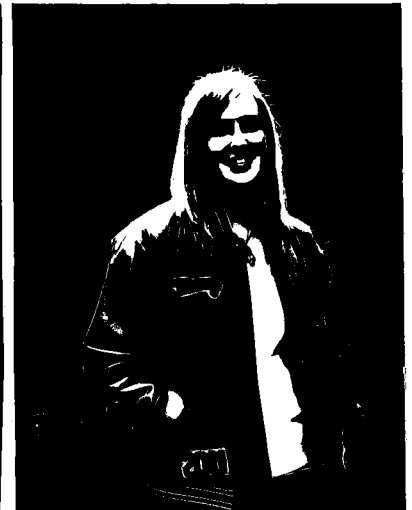

The Creston Alumni Association is proud to announce that sixteen scholarships totaling \$15,000 were awarded at the graduation in June 2011. Four scholarships were awarded to graduating seniors and twelve to former recipients. The seniors receiving awards of \$1,200 each were Victoria Brimberry, who will attend Eastern Washington University; Mary Pebles, who is planning to attend Central Washington University; Julie Salinas, who plans to attend North Idaho College; and Jacob Struve, who will use his award to attend Spokane Community College.

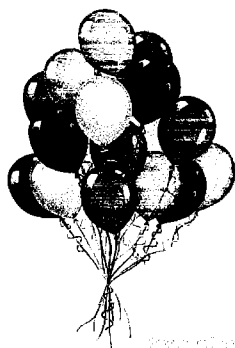

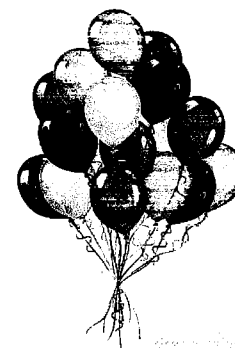

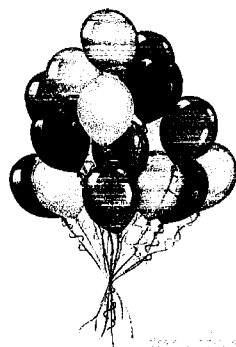
