CRESTON ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP 2020

The CRESTON ALUMNI ASSOCIATION was formed in 1996 with the primary focus being the development of a SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM for graduating seniors from Creston High School who plan to attend a college, university, or accredited vocational school. Funding for the scholarship will come from membership in and contributions to the ALUMNI ASSOCIATION from former graduates and supporters of the Creston Schools. Because of the recently formed Wilbur Creston High School Co-op, it is noted that these scholarships are designated for students registered as Creston School District students only.

A scholarship committee consisting of three to five members will direct the fund. The committee shall review applications for selection of recipients and all applicants will be considered without regard to race, color, sex or age. All information provided by the student or from references shall remain strictly confidential.

CRITERIA for the scholarship will be: 1) - personal desire and attitude of student towards the value of an education: 2) - financial need; 3) - scholastic achievement; 4) leadership attributes. Selection of a recipient(s) will be based on these categories, and the quality of the letter and application submitted by the student. All applications **MUST** be submitted in a binder or report cover.

Scholarships must be <u>received</u> by May 5, 2020. Faxed applications will not be considered. Late applications received <u>after</u> that date WILL NOT be considered – No exceptions.

Value of the scholarships may range from \$300 to \$1000 or more. The monies will be forwarded to the school AFTER the student has successfully completed the first quarter/semester of college and has registered for the second quarter/semester. NOTE: It is the responsibility of the student to provide proof of grades and registration to the alumni scholarship chairman in a timely manner. NO funds will be sent until this is completed. If the scholarship award is not used during the year of application the scholarship will be forfeited and the applicant must reapply. If the student begins school, but does not complete the quarter or semester, it is the responsibility of the student to reimburse the scholarship monies used for that quarter or semester to the association.

Scholarship recipients **MUST** write a thank you note to the Creston Alumni Association. Address your note to Creston Alumni Association, %Ann Krause, 32840 Swanson Lake Rd. N. Creston, WA 99117. Utilize this opportunity to tell about yourself, detailing your academic major or prospective academic interest, your future plans, and why the scholarship is important to you. **NOTE: Failure to meet these requirements will result in your note returned and requiring you to rewrite it, along with a** *possible delay* **of your scholarship funds.**

Scholarship winner(s) will be announced at the Wilbur Creston High School graduation ceremonies on June 6, 2020. First time recipients will be requested to attend the annual CRESTON ALUMNI ASSOCIATION Dinner and Reunion to be held on Saturday, September 12, 2020 for introduction and congratulations.

*Once you have completed the first quarter or semester of school, it is YOUR responsibility to send a copy of your grades, student ID number and complete address of financial aid office to Ann Krause before funds will be forwarded to the school.
